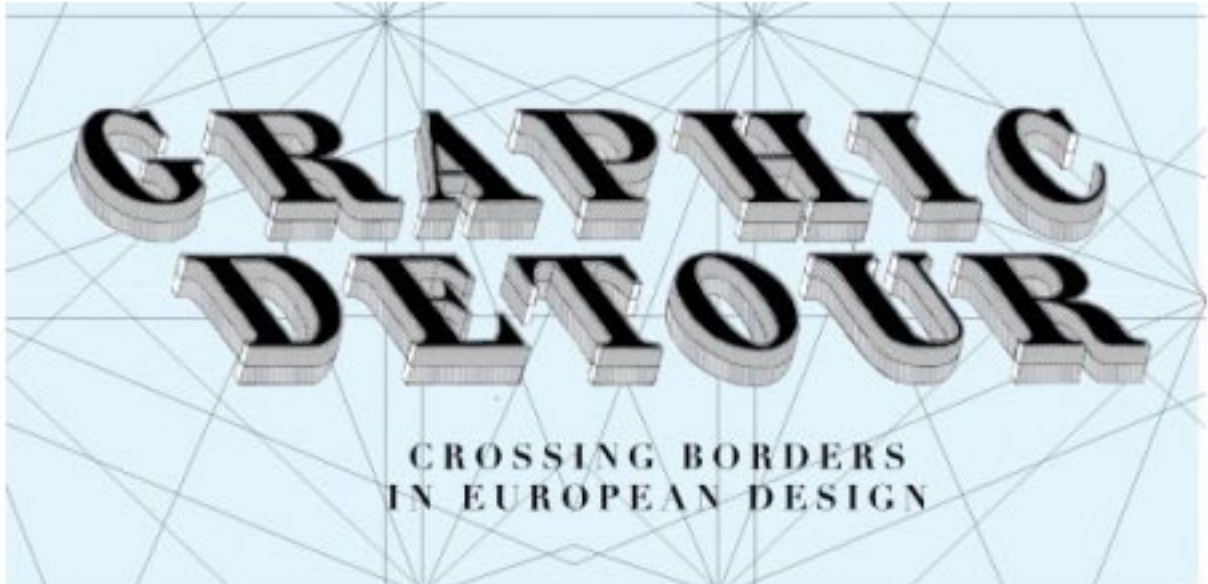


GRAPHIC DETOUR
